SPARKLING

Veuve Clicquot Brut NV £40.99

An archetypal champagne from a historic house. Madame A deceptively pale colour, with fine, persistent bubbles. A poised delicately beady nose, and on the palate a richness of fruit & a mousse that lingers on.

Lanson Black Label Brut NV £31.99

Brilliant and clear. In the glass, it is lively with a fine string of bubbles. The nose gives the impression of 'toast' and honey. On the palate are bouquets of ripe fruit and citrus fruit to create a sensation of fullness, fruitiness and lightness. A pleasant racy wine with a lingering finish.

Cremant D'Alsace Blanc 2007 Bleger, - Alsace France £18.49

A creamy, foaming sparkling wine made from 50% pinot Auxerrois, 40% Pinot Blanc, and 10% pinot gris. Its aromatic flavour develops during 24 months maturation.

Prosecco Bartolomeo – Veneto Italy £14.99

This wonderful dry, clean and crisp full-sparkling wine is obtained from the soft pressing of the best Prosecco grapes coming from the Breganza area, it has a light straw colour and a fruity bouquet with hints of green apples.

PORT

Churchill's Late Bottled Vintage 2002 Douro Portuga £20.95

A nose very full and fragrant with red berry fruits, violets and more than a hint of plummy sweetness, taste of fresh fruit, sweet and full with a touch of pepper, good length and fruity with just enough grip.

DESSERT WINES

Moscato D'Asti Volpi 2009 - Piedmont Italy £12.99

Made pleasantly sweet and lush. Light with wonderful fruit flavours, low alcohol at only 5.5 % yet long on flavour. This cleverly made light sparkling wine is stunning.

Sauternes Chateau Dudon 2001 – Barsac France £24.90

This delightful 13th Century Chateau produces stunning "stickies" A blend of Semillon and Sauvignon. Very sweet noble rot affected grapes produce this classic Sauternes with a hedonistic unctuous taste. This amazing sweet wine will keep for 100 years in the best vintages

WHITE WINE

Sauvignon Blanc 2008 Valde Vista– Chile Central Valley £10.49

Lovely intense aromas of citrus, green herbal notes with a touch of sweetness. On the palate, excellent acidity creates balance, a fine structure and a clean finish

Pinot Gris 2007 Bleger– Alsace France £18.99

Full, rounded wine it has flavours of lightly smoked wood. It develops a very characteristic opulence and has a long smooth finish

Gewurztraminer 2007 Bleger– Alsace France £19.49

An exuberant, powerful and attractive wine, probably the most famous of the wines of Alsace. Its intense bouquet develops rich exotic flavours of fruits, flowers and spices.

Pouilly Fuisse 2008 Trelen– Burgundy France £23.99

Brilliant pale gold. Nose of exotic fruits (passion fruit). This impression is confirmed by the frank, generous palate with its complex aromas of fresh butter, fern and lemon verbena. A harmonious, supple Pouilly Fuissé with a pure, long finish.

Macon Villages 2009 Trelen– Burgundy France £16.99

Brilliant light gold colour. Fresh fruit aromas (citrus) combine with a refreshingly floral nose. The supple, full palate is long and harmonious, ending on a pleasingly lemony note.

Chateaux d'Angles 2006 Coteaux du Languedoc £13.99

A stunning wine from former Lafite Rothschild award winning winemaker Eric Fabre. A blend of Bourboulenc, Grenache, Rousanne & Marsanne. A smooth wine with flavours of white flowers and citrus fruits. Highly praised by Jancis Robinson.

Pinot Grigio 2008 Montecelli– Veneto Italy £11.99

The wine has a strong yellow colour. The flavours are pleasantly aromatic, harmonic and velvet like. In fact this is a very good wine with all the ingredients of an excellent Pinot Grigio.

Sancerre 2008 Legros– Loire Valley France £19.49

Fresh lively nose of cooking apples, crisp full flavoured wine with lots of character, with a finish that rolls on.

Greco 2008 Villa Schinosa – Puglia Italy £15.49

The wine has a brilliant straw-yellow colour with an intense fragrance of exotic fruit and flowers. The flavours are elegant and full-bodied. This is an excellent food wine and does need food to be properly appreciated.

Sauvignon Blanc Maori Bay 2008 - Marlborough New Zealand £13.99

This wine represents everything typical for a Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc: Vibrancy and fruitiness, abundant aromas of pineapple, gooseberry and elderflower, hints of nettle and a lingering finish. Indulge!

Chenin Blanc Mountain Ridge 2010 – Western Cape South Africa £8.50

On the nose, lemon and lime aromas are abundant. A clean, lively wine with nuances of nutmeg and cloves. Well-balanced and elegant, but with weight and a powerful follow-through. The epitome of an easy drinking white wine.

RED WINE

Shiraz Cabernet 2007 – Trotwood South Eastern Australia £9.99

On the nose dark berries from the Cabernet with Shiraz adding plum and spice flavours. Dark fruit and spice on the palate with soft tannins. These flavours are further enhanced by the careful use of oak, which has added sweet vanilla and coffee characteristics.

Shiraz Cabernet Merlot 2006 Rampant Red Hamelin Bay - Margaret River Australia £16.99

Aromas of mint and earth harmoniously meld with cherry, plum and berry fruits to afford a complex bouquet. The palate is round and of medium weight.

Merlot/ Cabernet Sauvignon 2006 Chateau Haut-Dina – Cotes de Castillon £14.99

A bright medium bodied red, On the nose it is very fruity, with a rush of red fruit. Red cherry flavours on the palate,

and a smooth finish provides great value.

Merlot 2009 Valde Vista Central Valley Chile £10.49

The wine has a deep and beautiful cherry red colour. The nose seduces with a beautiful range of aromas of dried fruit, sweet cranberries and freshly baked cherry pie with soft toasty oak. Sweet tannins give backbone to this medium-bodied, well balanced wine which leads to a pleasant finish.

Pinot Noir 2009 Domaine Cabrials Pays D'Oc France £12.99

A nose full of rich plum fruit and a hint of spice. The palate is elegant and round with a good focus on fruit.

Gamay 2007 Trenal Morgon Cote du Py – Beaujolais France £17.99

Deep garnet in colour, this wine offers a sustained, complex nose of stone fruit combined with mineral notes. The highly vibrant palate has a sound underlying structure which is powerful yet velvety, thanks to tannins which, despite mellowing, are still very perceptible. This is a stylish wine bearing the hallmarks of its terroir and will make fine drinking over the next two to five years.

Negroamaro 2006 Sampietrana Salice Salentino Riserva £13.99

Ruby red with violet tones, intense nose of ripe red berry fruits with a hint of vanilla and toasted notes. Dry, warm and velvety. A beautiful wine winning Decanter silver medal 2009 world wine awards.

Sangiovese 2005 Casa Emma Chianti Classico – Chianti Italy £17.99

A blend of 90% Sangiovese, 10% Canaiolo and Malvasia Nero. A traditional Chianti with only Tuscan grape varieties in the blend. This wine is finely balanced with good acidity and mild tannins enabling the wine to be drunk now, an elegant wine.

Pinot Noir 2007 Dog Point – Marlborough new Zealand £26.00

Lovely cherry red colour with fresh redcurrants, raspberry and cherry aromas. The palate shows blackberry and redcurrant fruit with hints of lavender and a mineral undertone of dry slate. Very well balanced and tightly structured.

Tempranillo 2008 Bodegas Navajas Sin Rioja Spain - £11.99

With a big ruby colour and a hint of purple this young fruity wine explodes with luscious cherries and raspberries tempered by soft tannins from the small percentage of Mazuelo grapes in the blend

Malbec 2008 La Linda – Mendoza Argentina £11.99

Distinctive intense deep red color. Cherry and spicy aromas. On the palate, it displays balanced tannins obtained after ageing in French oak for three months. It is a velvety, elegant and modern wine with a sound structure

ROSE WINE

Merlot Valde Vista Rose 2009 – Central Valley Chile £10.49

A lively strawberry colour. A complex nose of grapefruit, strawberries and guava to excite ones senses.

Cinsault – Grenache – Syrah Ferrages Cuvee Roumery 2008 - Cotes de Provence £16.99

Rose petal colour with fresh and fruity aromas of red fruit. On the palate a good balance between freshness, structure, acidity and alcohol with a rich and soft body with red fruit dominating.
